



SUBJECT: DIVISION WEBINAR SERIES ON TEACHING GRAMMAR
COMMUNICATIVELY IN THE PHILIPPINES (TGCIP)

DATE: July 13, 2021

1. In compliance with Regional Memorandum No. 156, s. 2021, this Office, through the Curriculum and Instruction Division, informs the field of the conduct of Virtual Professional Learning and Development Sessions on Teaching Grammar Communicatively in the Philippines on August 2 to September 6, 2021. The virtual sessions shall be conducted every Monday afternoon only from 1:30 to 4:00 via Google Meet. The link shall be posted a day before the training
2. This webinar series aims to:
 - a. describe the Communicative Language Teaching (CLT) approach in relation to language acquisition and how they inform the characteristics of teaching grammar communicatively;
 - b. use the Form-Meaning-Use (FMU) framework to identify relevant grammar features and present grammar with selected activities;
 - c. explain why and how to integrate grammar into skills lessons;
 - d. identify and evaluate errors and use a variety of feedback and error correction technique; and
 - e. create communicative grammar lesson using a template.
3. Participants to this activity are the learning facilitators composed of the teachers, the school heads and the Education Program Supervisor who attended the National Training sponsored by the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and the 25 Junior High School teachers as participants who were selected regardless of gender, status, cultural and religious affiliations.
4. This Memorandum serves as Travel Order of the participants who opt to stay in an area with strong internet signal.
5. Travel expenses shall be charged to school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
