**IMPLEMENTATION OF "NO VACCINATION CARD AND NO QR CODE,
NO ENTRY" AND OTHER HEALTH MECHANISMS AT THE DIVISION OFFICE**

To: OIC-Schools Division Superintendent

All Elementary and Secondary School Principals/Heads
Unit/Section Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to Resolution No. 148-B, series of 2021, issued by the National Inter-Agency Task Force for Management of Infectious Disease (IATF) and due to the recent sharp increase of COVID-19 infection in the country, the Division of Northern Samar will adopt preventive health measures to mitigate the high probability of local transmission of Omicron variant of COVID-19 in the province.
2. All School Heads, teachers, and the transacting public are apprised that the Division Office shall strictly implement "No Vaccination Card and No QR Code, No Entry". Wearing facemasks and physical distancing must also be observed at the DO.
3. All Division Office Employees are likewise enjoined to present vaccination cards to allow entry.
4. The Guard on Duty may also require the clients to present valid identification cards aside from the vaccination card and QR Code and shall be ushered to the triage for a temperature check and other health protocols.



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5. The Health and Nutrition Section shall lead in the implementation of all COVID-19 preventive measures. In coordination with the General Services Unit, it shall ensure that the following mechanisms are carried out:
 - a. "No COVID-19 Vaccination Card and No QR Code, No Entry"
 - b. Conduct regular roving at the Division Office to ensure the wearing of facemasks and observance of social distancing of all inside the DO premise
 - c. Triage must be manned by health personnel at all times who must effect sternly triaging protocols.

6. This Memorandum shall take effect immediately.

7. Immediate dissemination and compliance are required.
