**DEPED NORTHERN SAMAR DELEGATION TO THE REGIONAL QUALIFYING  
EVENT FOR ATHLETICS 2022**

1. Pursuant to the attached DepEd Memorandum on the National Invitational Sports Competition (NISC) from the Office of the Undersecretary, dated March 21, 2022, and Regional Memorandum 397 s. 2022 from the Office of DepEd Region VIII Eastern Visayas dated April 27, 2022, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), shall participate in the conduct of the **Regional Qualifying Event for Athletics on May 19-21, 2022 at Ormoc City**. However, qualified athletes, coaches and delegation officials will stay at **Pambujan National High School, Pambujan Northern Samar on May 17-18, 2022** to have ample time to practice and familiarize the oval or the playing venue assigned by the host division

2. The objectives of this activity are the following:

2.1 Provide an alternative avenue in the efficient and effective identification and selection of student-athletes specifically for athletics as a substitute to an organized school sports tournament or competition such as the Eastern Visayas Regional Athletics Association which has been modified due to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic;

2.2 Identify and select the most athletically-talented secondary school student-athletes who shall form part of the regional delegation and compete against athletes from other regions across the country on **May 29-31, 2022 at Ilo-Ilo Sports Complex**.


3. Attached is the FINAL AND OFFICIAL LIST OF QUALIFIED ATHLETES IN ATHLETICS, COACHES AND DELEGATION OFFICIALS of the Northern Samar Division's Delegation to the Regional Qualifying Event for Athletics.

4. All concerned delegates will meet on May 18, 2022, at exactly 5:00 AM at the Pambujan National High School for the departure to Ormoc City.
5. The participants must be fully vaccinated and proof of vaccination such as vaccination cards or DOH-issued vaccination certificates and a medical certificate must be presented to the officials. All participants shall be adherent to the specified IATF protocols and guidelines.
6. There is no registration fee. However, all expenditures incurred relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against the SEF/ Local Funds/ Division MOOE / School MOOE or any available funds for foods, transportation and other incidental expenses subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. It is advised that the concerned Schools should guarantee that no classes will be left behind and should be managed by available teacher/s who will replace the coach involved in the said sports competition to ensure that students still obtain the full benefit of the curriculum-based instruction. Student athletes shall be given additional merits for their attendance to the said activity. They shall be allowed reasonable time to make up and comply with other requirements of the different subject areas including but not limited to quizzes and other examinations that they will miss.
8. Service Credits / CTO shall be granted to the participants to this activity who will render services on days that fall on weekends and holidays as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 67, s. 1988 and CSC Memo Circular No. 09, s. 1988.
9. All Coaches and Delegation Officials must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 (DepEd Child protection Policy). As such, all coaches and officials shall be responsible for the protection of student-athletes from abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying and other forms of abuse. All coaches and officials are reminded also to take precautionary measures in order to avoid accident before, during, and after the training. "CARE AND SAFETY OF STUDENT-ATHLETES ARE A TOPMOST PRIORITY".
10. All delegates should bring with them their own toiletries, utensils, sets of beddings with pillows and enough clothing for the whole duration of the qualifying event.
13. This Memorandum shall serve as Travel Order of all concerned involved in the conduct of 2022 Regional Qualifying Events for Athletics.
14. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum are desired.
