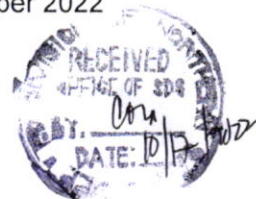

The following activities are identified to support the above AOGDs:


