ESKWELARAW sa NORTE

Rationale

The Department of Education is mandated by the 1987 Philippine Constitution to provide quality and relevant education. This is designed to produce learners that are critical thinkers and globally competitive. This is accentuated in the DepEd Vision, Mission and Core Values and expressed through the different programs and projects of the department.

RA 10533 as the basis provided specific and detailed implementation of school system including the school governance and learning delivery. Teaching and learning process is the main concern of the department. It is where the impact of education is measured through different forms of assessment.

The result of international and national assessment cannot justify the huge government financial share of the department. The regional validated result of the proficiency level in the different major fields is so dismaying.

The COVID-19 pandemic aggravated the chaotic loss of learning. The absence of 2-year in-person classes incurred a lot of damages in education. The Division of Northern Samar is not excuse to this problem in education. The result of reading assessment and numeracy tests challenged the division to implement *ESKWELARAW sa Norte* as our learning recovery program.

EskweLaraw is a combination of two Bisayan terms eskwela which means school and laraw which means plan. EskweLaraw sa Norte is a learning plan of Northern Samar to be implemented in all school including learning centers to recover learning losses. This learning recovery program covers all learners in the division in the formal education, the Alternative Learning System (ALS), the Madrasah Education Program (MEP), Special Education (SpEd) and Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd). It is along these plan that the

Division of Northern Samar contextualized a project for literacy and numeracy dubbed as "SANA All Readers" (Strategic Activities for Nortehanon schools to Achieve All Readers) as every school target for SY 2022-2023 and even beyond. SANA All Readers program is a vehicle of EskweLaraw. It is an implementation strategy to ensure every Nortehanon learner can read, will read, and is literate. It is a commitment shared by everyone in the education sector to make every Nortehanon learner a reader at his/her grade level.

Strategic Directions

In adherence to the Education Development Plan of the national, regional and this division, this learning recovery program aims towards the following strategic direction:

- Intensify the implementation of Basic Education Curriculum and Special Curriculum Programs
- Effective management of learning assessment for better learning outcomes
- Develop contextualized learning resources by learning area for schools and Learning Centers
- Establish a conducive and healthy learning environment that hazard-free and child-friendly
- Capacitate teachers and school leaders in the implementation of programs and projects
- Establish partnership and linkages to different stakeholders
- Institutionalize monitoring and supervision that is immersed in the school and classroom
- Validation of the data gathered from the monitoring and supervision
