

Pursuant to Section 30 of Republic Act No. 11223, or the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act, schools under the supervision of the Department of Education will be designated as **healthy settings**, with DepEd and the Department of Health developing standards, programs, and modules on health literacy, health promotion, and disease prevention. All of these will be addressed through the Healthy Learning Institutions (HLI) program of the DOH.

In line with the above, the 2023 HLI program aims to help the country take the first step in fulfilling the obligations as well as other responsibilities as stated in the Joint Administrative Order providing Guidelines on Healthy Settings Framework in Learning Institutions. Through this, the DOH EVCHD will assist selected last mile schools in implementing an integrated, end-to-end package of interventions complementing and strengthening the existing Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd (OKD) programs. Furthermore, this will test the process of planning, coordinating, cascading, cascading, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating the HLI framework with DepEd.
