- 1. In compliance with the Omnibus Rules on Appointment and Other Human Resource Actions (ORA-OHRA), Regional Memorandum No. 729 s. 2023, DepEd Order No. 03 s. 2016, and DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2023 re: Guidelines on Recruitment, Selection, and Appointment in the Department of Education, this Office hereby directs all schools with Senior High School Programs to facilitate the conduct of school-based ranking for Senior High School Teacher II Positions.
- 2. The Personnel Selection Board in the Secondary School with existing department heads shall be composed of the following:

For secondary schools with no existing department heads, the school head shall designate the members of the committee from among the senior faculty on the basis of qualification and competence.

- 3. School Heads shall inform and call all qualified permanent teachers to apply for the position and submit documents for applications on the specific date set by the school screening committee.
- 4. Paragraph VII of DepEd Order No. 03 s. 2016 shall apply in the computation of points.
- 5. The School Comparative Assessment Result (CAR) shall be submitted to the Schools Division Office for assessment and appointment on or before a week after the conduct of school ranking.
- 6. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
