CONDUCT OF MONITORING ACTIVITIES ON THE KEY STAGE 1 FOUNDATION FOR EFFECTIVE LEARNING TRANSITIONS (K-3 FELT) PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Supervisors Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Principals in-Charge Secondary and Elementary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 898, s. 2023 titled, **Implementation** Guidelines on the Key Stage 1 Foundation for Effective Learning Transitions (K-3 FELT) Project, this Office shall conduct monitoring activities on the extent and effectiveness of the project implementation from October 16 to November 17, 2023 to select schools of the 46 districts.
- The activity aims to:
 - Ascertain the extent of implementation of K-3 FELT Project and discuss issues and concerns;
 - b. Conduct a 30-minute to one-hour coaching and mentoring session after the observations on the class routines, differentiated activities, and literacy pedagogy to select teachers, in coordination with the District Heads and School Heads; and
 - c. Provide technical assistance on possible adjustments based on the feedback and observations during the monitoring activities.
- 3. The List of Monitors and the Monitoring Tool to be used in the conduct of the aforesaid activities are herewith attached as Enclosures 1 and 2, respectively.
- 4. An orientation on the use of the K-3 FELT Monitoring Tool and the mechanics of the monitoring activity is set on October 13, 2023 at 9:00 AM at the CID office to be participated by the EPSs.
