STREAMLINING THE NATIONAL DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM (NDEP) IN CELEBRATION OF THE DRUG ABUSE AND PREVENTION AND CONTROL WEEK 2024

1. This, Office, through the Schools and Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) – School Health Section (SHS), shall conduct a week-long activity on November 18-22, 2024, entitled: Streamlining the National Drug Education Program (NDEP) in Celebration of the Drug Abuse and Prevention and Control Week 2024. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 124, dated November 26, 2001, declaring the third week of November as Drug Abuse and Prevention and Control Week. Guided by this year's theme, "The Evidence is Clear: Invest in Prevention", the celebration serves as a powerful reminder that effective drug prevention relies on science, grounded in research, compassion, and full respect for human rights.

2. The activity aims to:

- a. promote awareness on the ill effects of abusing drugs and promoting positive behavior and life skills among learners to resist drugs, employing standard, age and gender sensitive methods of demand generation;
- b. strengthen the skills and competence of school health personnel, guidance counselors/ guidance designates, teaching and non-teaching personnel in implementing year-round NDEP activities/advocacies and programs in maintaining Drug-Free Schools/ Workplaces.
- c. reinforce partnership with other government agencies and other stakeholders in strengthening NDEP in the entire community;









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- d. highlight NDEP in celebration of the **Drug Abuse and Prevention and Control Week**, conforming to the event's theme, advocacies and activities.
- 3. During the conduct of this week-long activity, all Schools Division Office (SDO) personnel and all schools are enjoined to participate in the conduct of the following activities:

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- 4. School Heads/ Class advisers/ School NDEP coordinators or any school personnel designated to facilitate the conduct of the aforementioned activities shall utilize the homeroom time, vacant period or designate a specific day and time within the said week, ensuring that there would be no disruption of classes.
- 5. For documentation, all schools shall submit the following Means of Verifications (MOVs):
 - a. Video recordings (short videoclips minimum 5 minutes) of program highlights,
 - b. Photographs during conduct of the school activities,
 - c. Accomplishment Report of symposiums/ lay fora/ health talks or related activities (see attached recommended Form/ Template). MOVs shall be submitted to Ms. Glenda T. Tepace SDO Focal Person for NDEP, through the link https://bit.ly/NSamarNDEPMOVs2024.
- 6. The aforementioned activities shall be promoted by ALL SCHOOL HEALTH SECTION PERSONNEL, including those assigned in Autonomous Schools or those under School-Based Plantilla through provision of necessary technical assistance and active participation/ monitoring/ attendance during the conduct of recommended school activities
