**STANDARD FIRST AID AND BASIC LIFE SUPPORT – CPR CUM DISASTER
RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT AND HYGIENE PROMOTION
DISSEMINATION TRAINING**

1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 10871, titled Basic Life Support Training in Schools Act that covers all public and private basic education schools and institutions, including Alternative Learning Systems (ALS) learning centers. This Office through the SGOD – Social Mobilization & Networking Section (Disaster Risk Reduction Management) will be conducting the Standard First Aid and Basic Life Support – CPR Cum Disaster Risk Reduction Management And Hygiene Promotion Dissemination Training on December 01-05, 2024 at 1:00 PM at Ciriaco Hotel, Calbayog City.
2. The activity aims to:
 - To acquire skills that include injury prevention content and basic bandaging;
 - To understand the importance of knowing first aid, to pass skills and knowledge onto others by learning to teach first aid; and
 - To acquire the simplified approach to making first aid training accessible for emergency use of Teachers and Learners.
3. Participants in this activity are the forty-six (46) District DRRM Coordinators, forty-one (41) Health and Nutrition Nurses, Nine (9) Project Development Officer 1 and One Hundred (100) ALS Mobile Teachers.
4. The Public Schools District Supervisors are advised to assign a proxy if the District DRRM Coordinators and ALS mobile Teachers are not available to attend the training.
5. All expenses relative to the conduct of the activity are charged to 2023 DRRM Fund/ PAPS except for the traveling and incidental expenses of the school participants which are chargeable against their respective school local/MOOE funds.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


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
